
Sunlight Zone	Twilight Zone	Midnight Zone
The top layer of the ocean is home to most marine life and is the warmest. This is the layer with the most natural light.	Only some light enters the second ocean layer. The fourth layer is pitch black on the ocean floor. The ocean floor is covered with muddy material from organic waste.	This is the deepest layer of the ocean found in canyons and trenches. The pressure here is over 8 tons per square inch.	A ridge or group of rock- like structures made up of groups of small sea animals shaped like tubes.
