Line 1: One word that tells what your poem is about (its subject)

Line 2: Two words that describe your subject

Line 3: Three action words that end in -ing and describe something your subject does

Line 4: A phrase that describes something else about your subject

Line 5: One or two words that rename what your poem is about (a synonym)
