



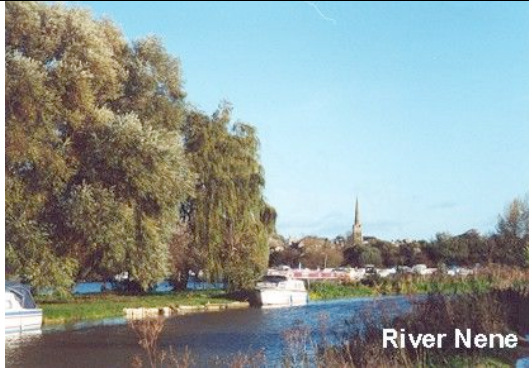
Desert – Large land that receives little rainfall

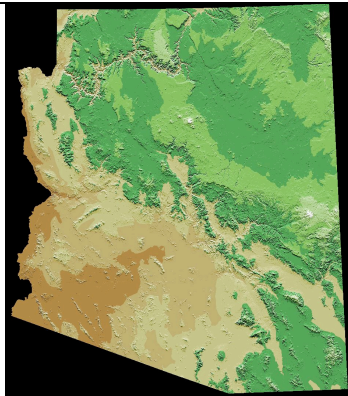


River – A large body of fresh water that moves from higher to lower land
