**1943** - Branch Rickey became manager of Brooklyn Dodgers.

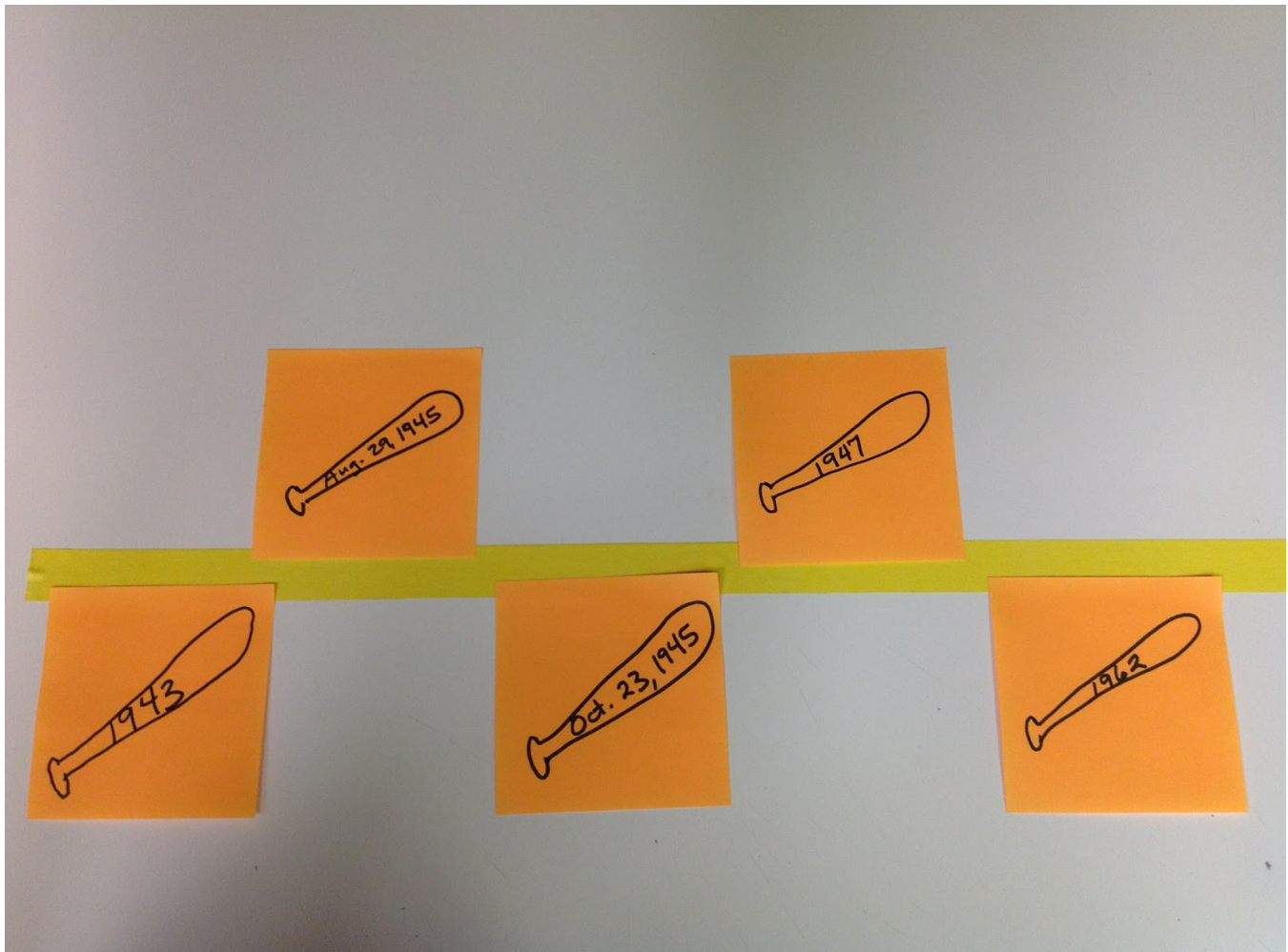
**August 29, 1945** - Rickey and Robinson meet.

**October 23, 1945** - Jackie Robinson signed with the Monarchs (Negro League team).

**April 15, 1947** - Opening Day for Dodgers (Jackie plays for the Brooklyn Dodgers.)

**1962** - Jackie was elected to the Baseball Hall of Fame.

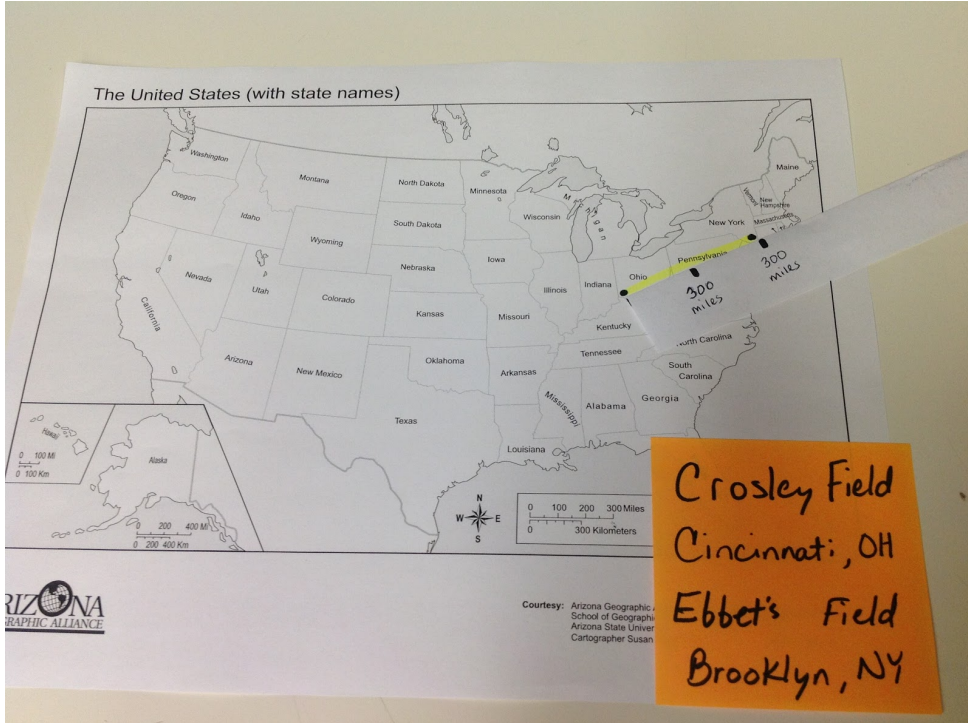


## Examples of Baseball Cards for Game

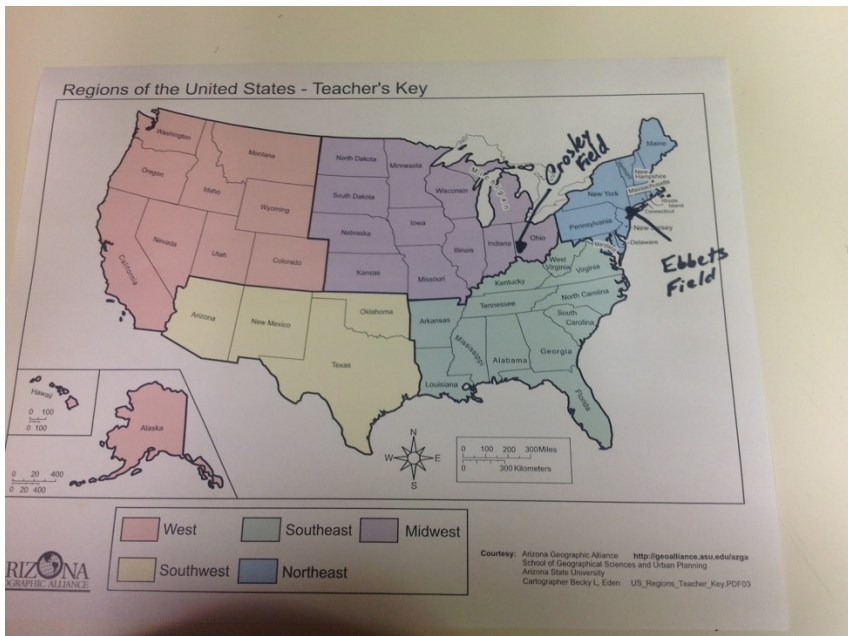
<p>Two wonderful baseball leagues.</p> <p><b><u>(A double)</u></b></p>	<p>Laws against segregation didn't exist in 1940.</p> <p><b><u>(1 Strike)</u></b></p>
<p>Hotels didn't rent rooms to black people, so Negro League players slept in cars.</p> <p><b><u>(1 Strike)</u></b></p>	<p>Vigilante groups, like the Ku Klux Klan, reacted violently against those who tried to change the way blacks were treated.</p> <p><b><u>(Strike out)</u></b></p>
<p>Branch Rickey did not care what color of skin, he wanted the best players on his league.</p> <p><b><u>(A triple)</u></b></p>	<p>A star player who possessed self-control not to fight back against opposition.</p> <p><b><u>(Homerun)</u></b></p>
<p>Rickey and Robinson were starting the "great experiment".</p> <p><b><u>(A single)</u></b></p>	<p>First black player to try out for a Major League team.</p> <p><b><u>(Homerun)</u></b></p>
<p>Opposing players were cruel to Jackie, calling him nasty names.</p> <p><b><u>(Strike out)</u></b></p>	<p>Jackie made the Brooklyn Dodgers team.</p> <p><b><u>(A triple)</u></b></p>
<p>Only white players were allowed in the hotels.</p> <p><b><u>(1 strike)</u></b></p>	<p>Jackie often felt very alone.</p> <p><b><u>(1 strike)</u></b></p>
<p>Pee Wee told himself, "If Jackie is good enough to take my job, he deserves it."</p> <p><b><u>(A double)</u></b></p>	<p>Only white players had their pictures on baseball cards.</p> <p><b><u>(1 strike)</u></b></p>
<p>Many Americans knew that racial prejudice was wrong, but few dared to help.</p> <p><b><u>(Strike out)</u></b></p>	<p>Pee Wee wouldn't sign the petition to throw Jackie off the team.</p> <p><b><u>(Homerun)</u></b></p>

<p>Fans in the crowd screamed terrible, hateful things at Jackie.</p> <p><b><u>(1 Strike)</u></b></p>	<p>Pee Wee took a stand and put his arm around Jackie.</p> <p><b><u>(A triple)</u></b></p>
<p>Jackie did nothing to provoke the hostility against him, except to be treated as an equal.</p> <p><b><u>(A triple)</u></b></p>	<p>Pee Wee smiled at Jackie and said, “This man is my teammate.”</p> <p><b><u>(Homerun)</u></b></p>
