

baray—artificial lake created to hold water



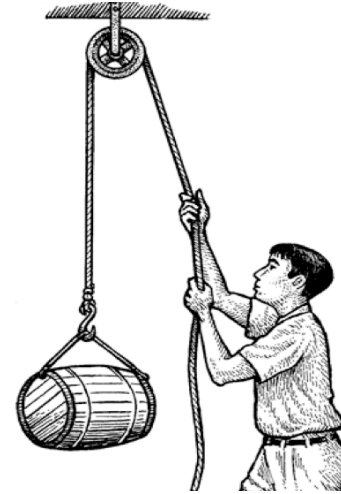

scaffold—a temporary place built so a person can work above the ground



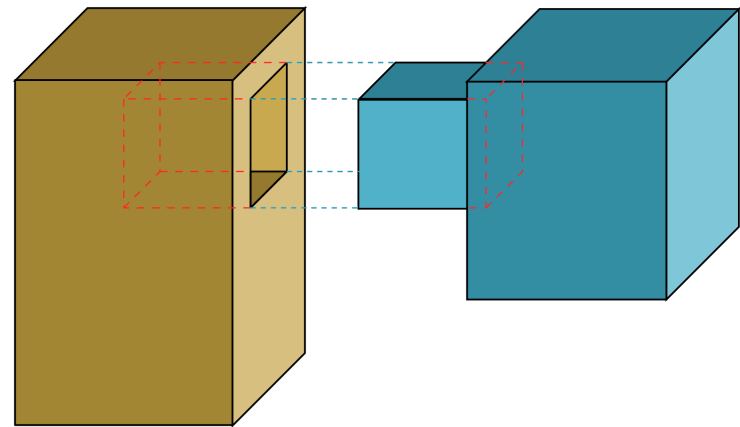

pulley—a machine used to lift or lower heavy objects



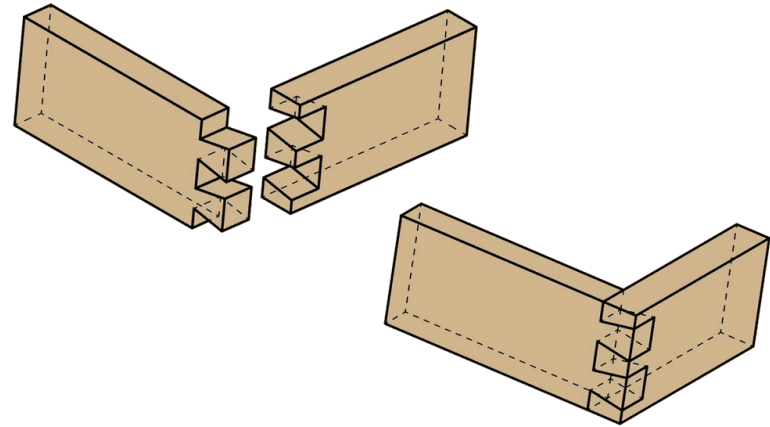
