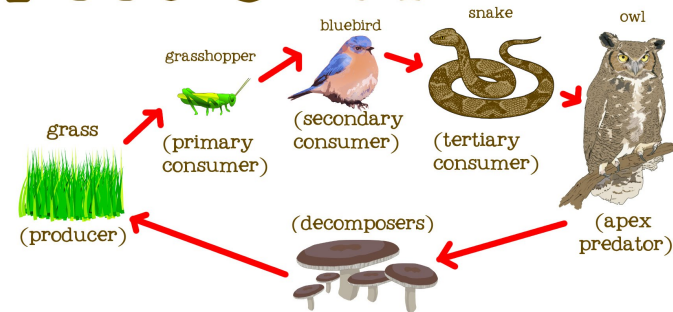
plankton: microscopic aquatic organisms

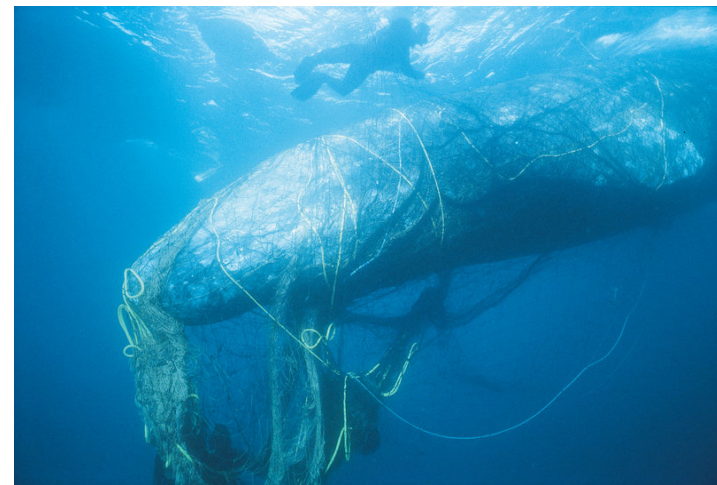
food chain: group of organisms linked in order of the food they eat, from producers to consumers, and from prey, predators, scavengers, and decomposers
