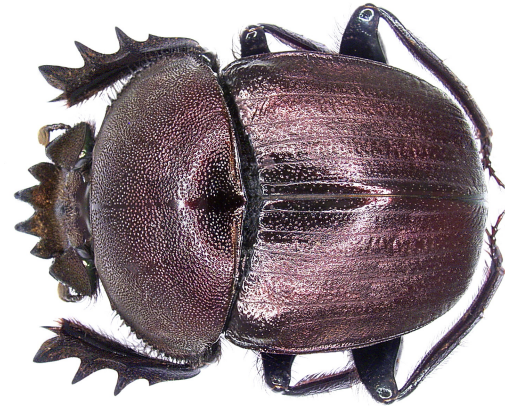


scarab – a large beetle with a black shell, in ancient Egypt it was the symbol of good luck and eternal afterlife
