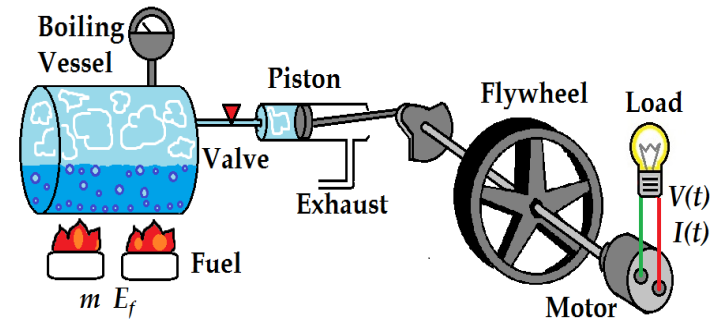


**steam engine:** an engine powered by steam. Steam engines can power boats, trains, cars, and machines.



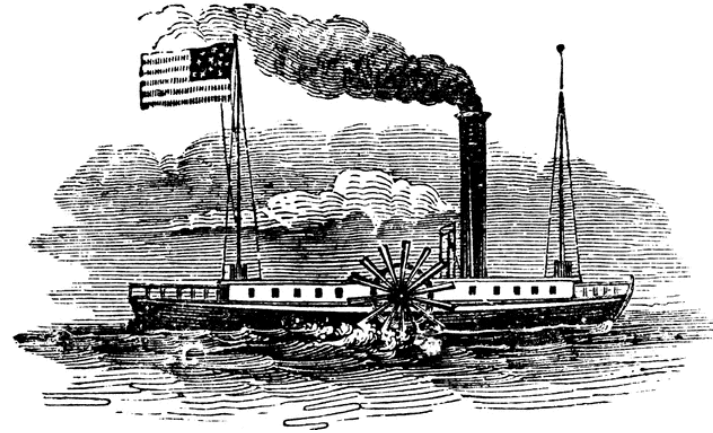

**technology** – useful things to solve problems



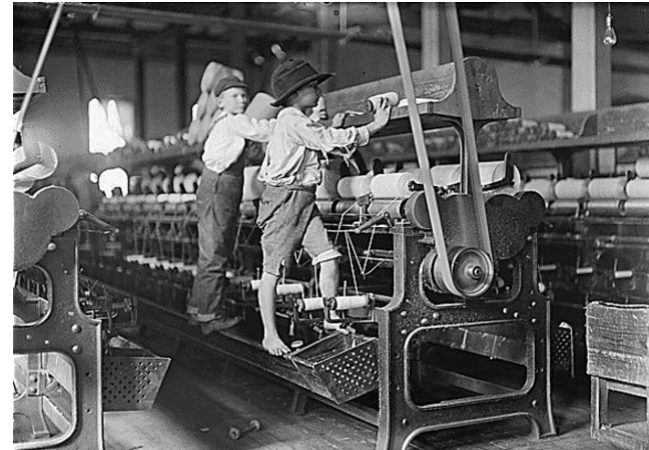

Examples of how to use “reliable” in a sentence:

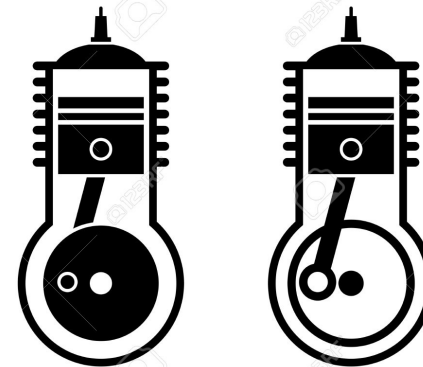
- 1.) Joe comes to work everyday and is a **reliable** worker.
