river – a large natural stream of water emptying into an ocean, lake, or other body of water



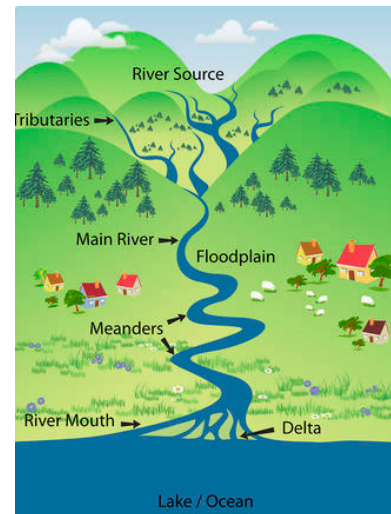
