Slide 4 Describe 3 differences between the two diseases.

Slide 5 Identify at least 5 impacts from epidemics or pandemics on the lives of people. One of these impacts must share how people worked cooperatively to fight the disease. One of the impacts must share how conflict was created from the effects of the pandemic/epidemic.

Slide 6 Give at least one coping strategy for stress caused by COVID-19. A coping strategy is something that makes you feel better and lessens the stress.

Slide 7 What is a memory of the COVID pandemic that you will share with your children or others in 30 years from now.
