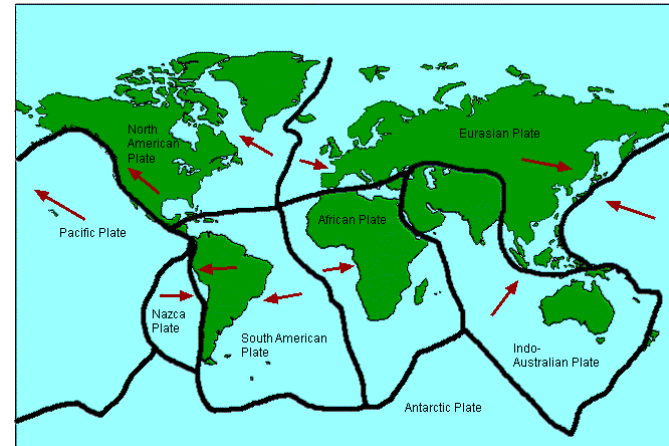
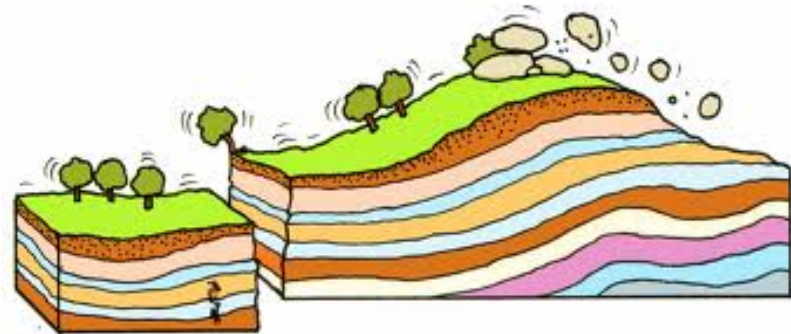


tectonic plates: plates of rock that make up the earth's crust



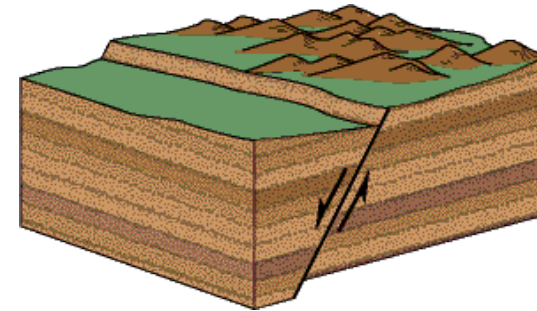

earthquake: moving of the Earth's surface due to a movement of a fault



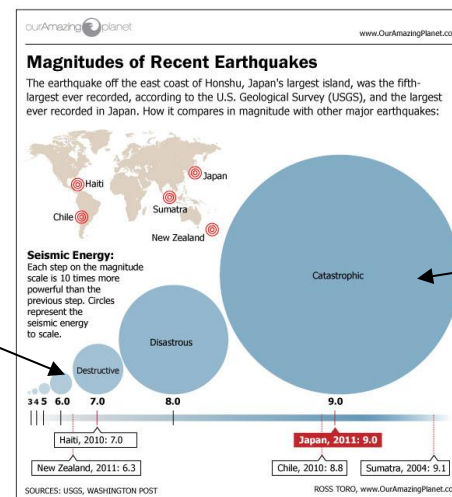

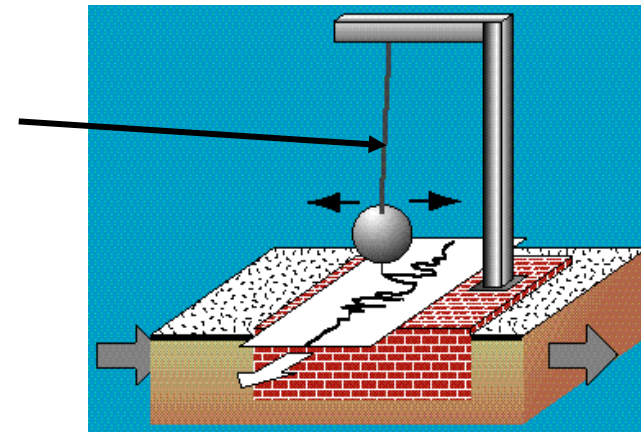

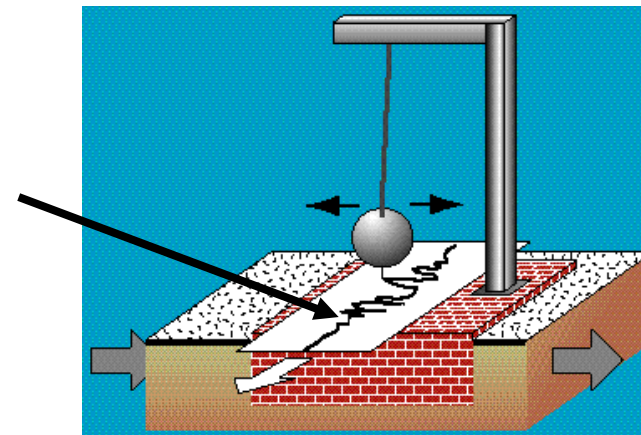
