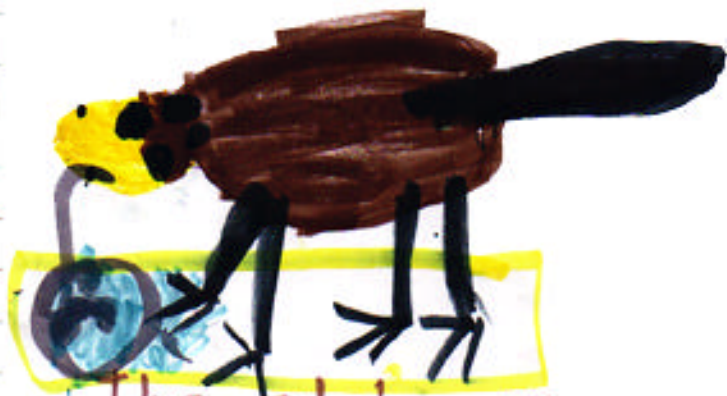
Combined Route:
