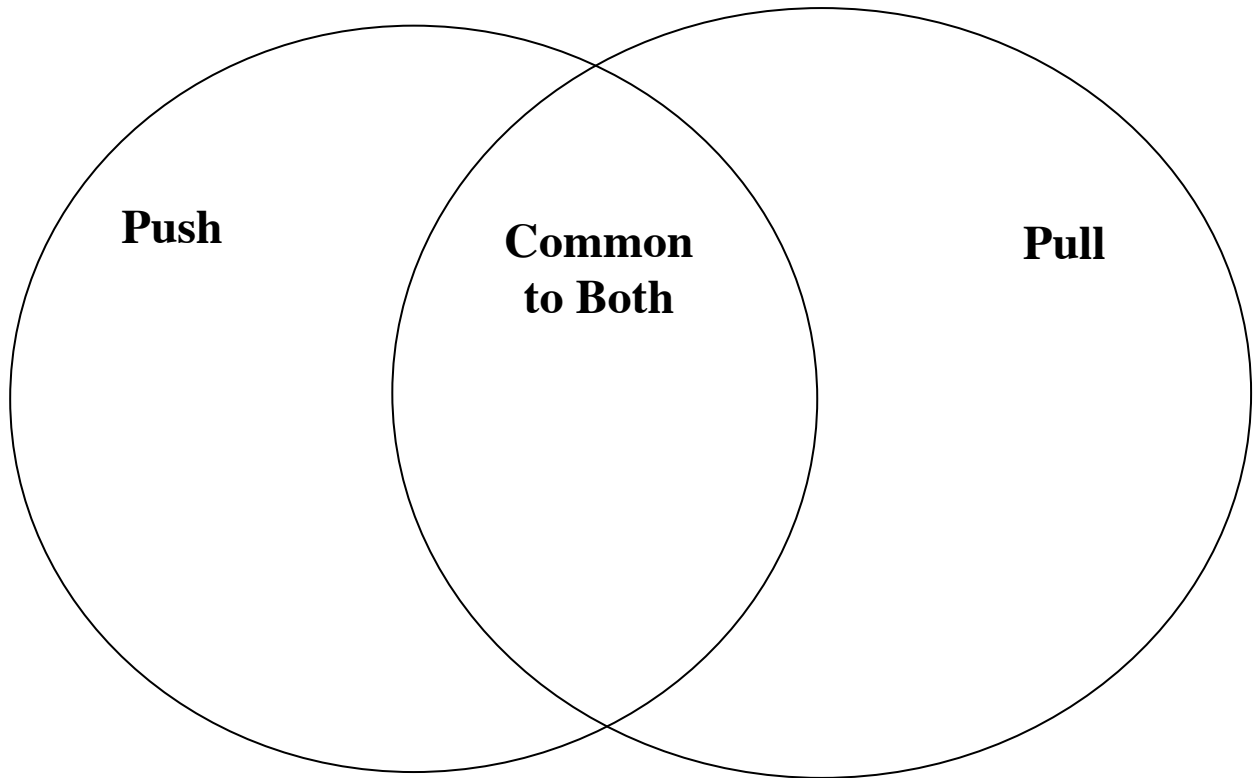

Possible Answer: Many bad things happened to Esperanza and her family, so they all packed up to move to California to find work.

Possible Answer: Her uncles wanted all of her family's money so they needed to get away and hide from them.

Possible Answer: Her father died and her mother had no way of making money in Mexico so she needed to find a job in California.

Push-Pull Factors

Push

- They no longer have a place to live.
- Her uncle tried proposing to Mamá and tried to take all of their money.
- There was no work for her family in Aguascalientes, Mexico.

Pull

- Cheap housing on the migrant field.
- Making new friends.
- Escaping her evil uncles.
- Leaving her sadness of Papá dying behind.
- Better opportunities for work.

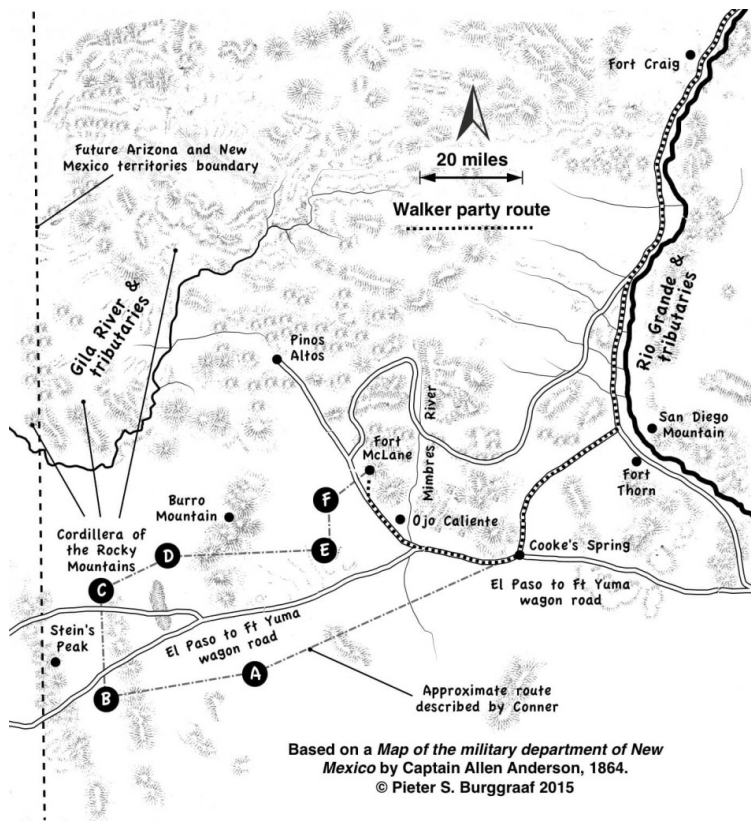
