Transportation

1800 – On foot

Horseback

Few or no roads

Now – Automobiles (self-driving as well)

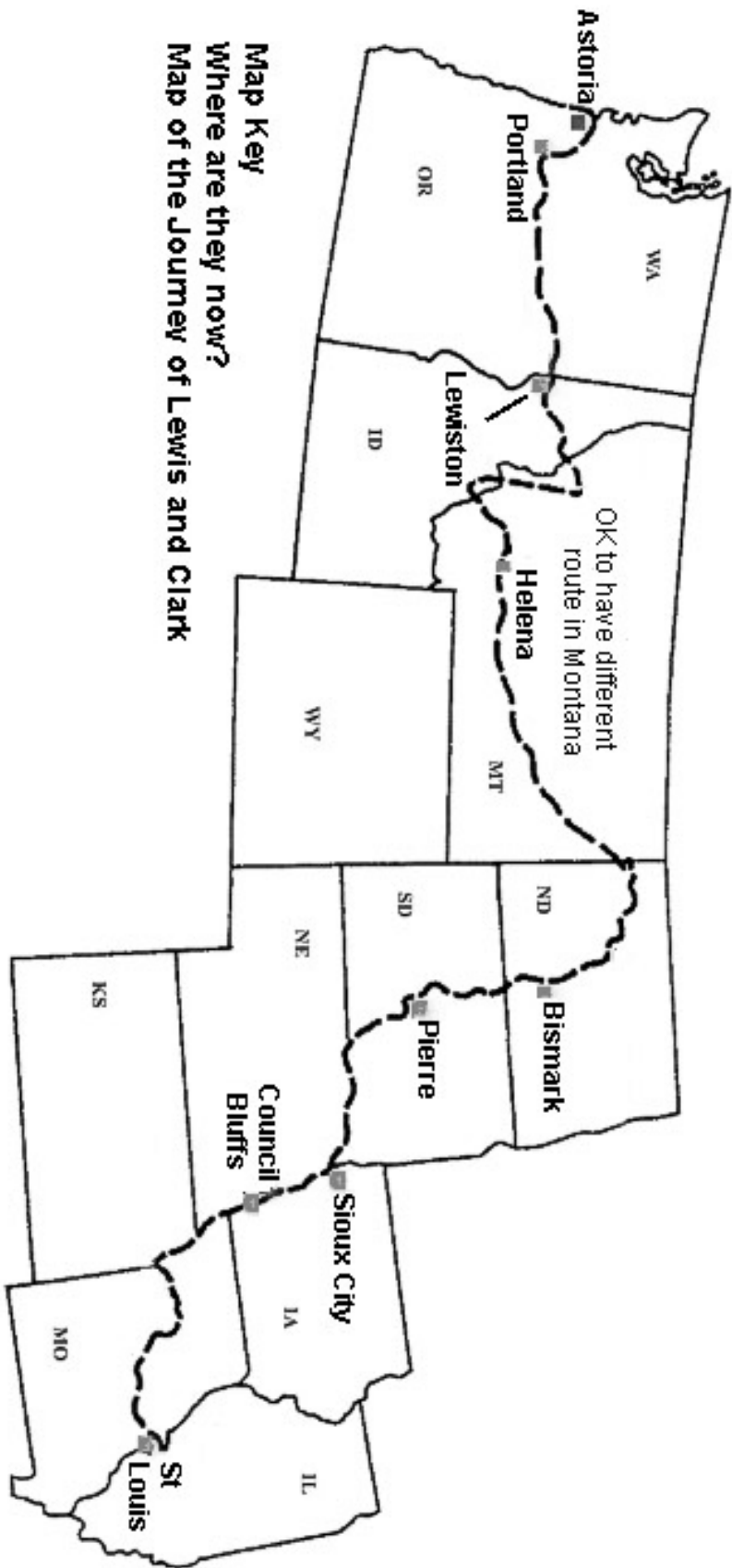
