


FOR MAPPING A CLASSROOM**




Chair

## Scoring Rubric

Score	Correct Number of Each Shape	Shapes Identifiable	Shapes Correctly Placed
<b>0</b>	No effort is shown.	No effort is shown.	No effort is shown.
<b>1</b>	Student cut at least one shape.	Shape is not identifiable.	Shape is randomly glued.
<b>2</b>	Student cut some shapes.	Shapes loosely resemble correct shape.	Shapes are glued anywhere.
<b>3</b>	Student cut almost all the shapes. May have missed as many as 10% of required number.	Shapes generally correct – correct number of sides and angles – may be uneven or crooked.	Shapes are glued in the near vicinity of real locations – correct to within 1 inch.
<b>4</b>	Student cut all or nearly all of required shapes, may have missed one or two.	Shapes are easily identifiable – straight sides, sharp angles.	Shapes are glued in the correct or almost correct spot.
