1943 - Branch Rickey became manager of Brooklyn Dodgers.


August 29, 1945 - Rickey and Robinson meet.

April 15, 1947 - Opening Day for Dodgers (Jackie plays for the Brooklyn Dodgers.)

## **Examples of Baseball Cards for Game**


Two wonderful baseball leagues.	Laws against segregation didn't exist in 1940.
(A double)	(1 Strike)
Hotels didn't rent rooms to black people, so Negro League players slept in cars.  (1 Strike)	Vigilante groups, like the Ku Klux Klan, reacted violently against those who tried to change the way blacks were treated.  (Strike out)
Branch Rickey did not care what color of skin, he wanted the best players on his league.	A star player who possessed self-control not to fight back against opposition.
(A triple)	(Homerun)
Rickey and Robinson were starting the "great experiment".	First black player to try out for a Major League team.

(A double)	(1 strike)
Many Americans knew that racial prejudice was wrong, but few dared to help.	Pee Wee wouldn't sign the petition to throw Jackie off the team.
(Strike out)	(Homerun)




Fans in the crowd screamed terrible, hateful things at Jackie.	Pee Wee took a stand and put his arm around Jackie.
