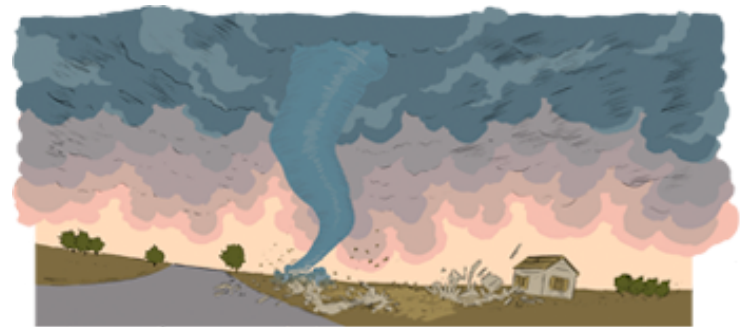


dust storms: a strong wind that carries fine particles of dust for long distances
