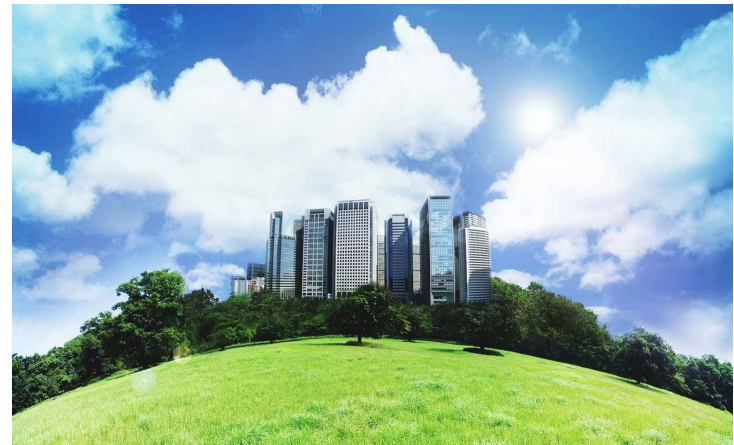


disposable: made to be used once and thrown away
